 - 1,5 million in Romania
 - 0,5 million in Slovakia
 - 0,3 million in Serbia
 - 0,2 million in Ukraine
 - 0,2 million in Western-Europe
 - 0,1 million in Croatia, Slovenia, Austria, Czech Republic
 - 0,1 million in the USA
 - 0,1 million in Canada

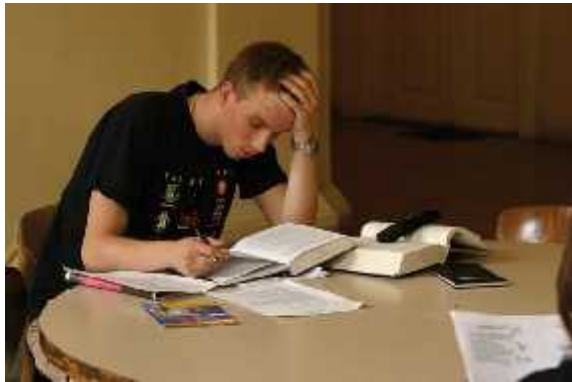
