Faculty of informatics and communication Engineering

- ▶ Includes 4 departments:
 - ▶ Software Engineering.
 - ▶ Information and Communication Engineering.
 - ▶ Computer and Digital Systems Engineering.
 - ▶ Information Systems Engineering.



Faculty of Civil, Environmental and Architectural Engineering.

- ▶ Includes 2 departments:
 - ▶ Civil and Environmental Engineering.
 - ▶ Architectural Engineering.



Faculty of Administrative and Financial Sciences

- ▶ Includes 6 departments:
 - ▶ Finance and Banking.
 - ▶ Management.
 - ▶ Marketing.
 - ▶ Management Information Systems.
 - ▶ International Business Administration.
 - ▶ Accounting and Business Law.



Admission Criteria

- ▶ The university follows the admission criteria issued by the Ministry of Higher Education in Syria, which sets minimum high school average as minimum entry criteria for the different majors. The minimum averages are:

Faculty	Minimum High School Average
Informatics and Communication Engineering	60%
Civil, Environmental and Architectural Engineering	60%
Administrative and Financial Sciences	50%

- ▶ Regulations allow the university to impose higher entry criteria, which usually happens by special committee decision made annually.



Graduation Requirements

- ▶ The university follows American credit hours system. The total credits required for graduation are as follows:

Faculty or Department	Total Credit Hours
Informatics and Communication Engineering	168
Civil and Environmental Engineering	168
Architectural Engineering	169
Administrative and Financial Sciences	132



Exams and students' evaluation

- ▶ Students are evaluated during the semester based on exams, homework, and different activities. Students' evaluation criteria in all courses include the following.
 - ▶ Midterm Exam allotted 20% of course grade.
 - ▶ Final Exam allotted 50-60% of course grade.
 - ▶ Quizzes with 10 to 20% of course grade.
 - ▶ The remainder of the course grade (10 to 20%) is assigned to homework, projects, and academic activities.
